Annual report 2018-2019

The journey of CMS CET started on 10th February 2009 with a Vision of “A Centre of Excellence, Capable of empowering seekers of knowledge through holistic education”.

The college maintains high standards of Education by providing a wide array of world-class Academic facilities; Employing highly qualified and experienced Faculty Members and creating an ambience conducive to quality education.

Student’s strength and weakness in academics are accessed and gaps are filled through various Bridge & Certificate courses, Modules on Personality Development & Life Skills, Courses on Global Competencies.

The following curriculum and co-curricular activities were organised for the academic year 2018-19,

- As per the guidelines of Anna University, the academic calendar was prepared at the beginning of the academic year.
- Number of students studied during the academic year is 557.
- Number of Full time teaching Faculty the Academic year is 87
- Number of actual students admitted from reserved category during the academic year is 12.
- ICT facility was provided to all department classrooms for effective teaching learning process for the benefit of students and teachers.
- Value added courses were organized by all the departments every semester to develop the students to face placement activities and competitive exams. In this academic year total 14 value added courses




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were organized by all departments and 403 students completed the course successfully.

- Number of Teaching Faculty attended faculty development/training Program is 68 and Non-teaching faculty members attended training program is 15.
- Total of 45 teaching and non-teaching faculty members were provided financial support for Faculty development programmes, webinar and conference in this academic year 2018-19. A total financial support amounting to Rs.20400/- was provided to these faculties.
- CMSCET NSS unit organized 11 programmes inside and outside the campus as a part of extension and outreach programme.
- Received feedback from all stakeholders, students, teachers, employees, alumni and parents and remedial steps were taken for all the grievances.
- All academic and non-academic problems were discussed in class committee meeting, and appropriate steps were taken to rectify the problem, if any.
- As per AICTE, the Mentor-Mentee scheme with a ratio of 1:15 is followed, for individual attention and care.
- Overall Pass percentage for this academic year 2018-19 is 73.33 %
- A total of 62 publications was contributed by our staff members in this academic year in both International and national journal publications.
- Total number of books, chapters, edited volumes and papers in national and international conference proceedings during the academic year 2018-19 is 18.
- Total MoU signed with organizations for In-Plant training and internship for this academic year is 2.
- An ERP CMS-IMS project was proposed.



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- The Department of Civil engineering and Mechanical engineering received total fund of Rs. 11.12 Lakhs from 3 Non-Government organisations.
- Amount spent for Infrastructure and maintained of academic and physical facility, in this academic year, is Rs. 294.77 L
- 436 Students received scholarship amounting to Rs.1, 41, 92, 600 from Central/State Government and CMS Trust.
- 356 students attended the Competitive exam and Career Guidance programme offered by the institution
- Student's performance in internal test and semester marks and their attendance details were communicated to the parents through mobile and letters.
- Parent teachers meeting were conducted in each semester to review the performance of the students.
- Students actively participated in sports and cultural events, a total of 20 events, was organised by the institution
- Library advisory committee ensures that there are sufficient number and volume of books and e-journals. Digital library facilities are maintained through library software.
- Number of workshops/seminars/conference conducted on Research Methodology, Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and entrepreneurship during the year is 7.
- Number of students placed in the campus drive for the academic year 2018-2019 is 110.




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
